DESCRIPTION The 87,000 sq. ft. cheese processing plant and cold storage facility adjacent to the Columbia River is a satellite cheese processing plant of Tillamook Creamery. The plant includes concrete tilt-up thermomass panels which give security yet still maintain a well insulated building and a walkable insulated panel deck over the entire building interior for sanitation and easy equipment and piping access. The facility was built on 22 acres at the Port of Morrow. The objective of the Columbia River Processing project was to construct and put into operation a 58 million pound per year Tillamook Cheese manufacturing facility. This \$50 million building includes processing, milk receiving, cold storage, dry storage, utilities maintenance and administration.
