



## Columbia River Processing, Inc. EXPANSION

**Boardman, Oregon** 



## **DESCRIPTION**

The project is a major expansion to the existing cheese making plant for Columbia River Processing located in Boardman, Oregon. This expansion has doubled the plant's capacity for producing Tillamook Cheese with minimal disruption to the ongoing cheese-making operations. The existing 90,000 sf facility will be expanded with approximately 20,000 sf of new refrigerated warehouse space, 25,000 sf of new process space, expanded storage and receiving facilities, and an expansion to the plant office areas. The main process area is constructed similar to the existing plant utilizing insulated tilt-up concrete wall panels for the building envelope. Internally, the process areas are finished with acid-brick flooring, ceramic tile walls and have a walkable insulated panel ceiling over the entire process area for sanitation and easy equipment and piping access.
